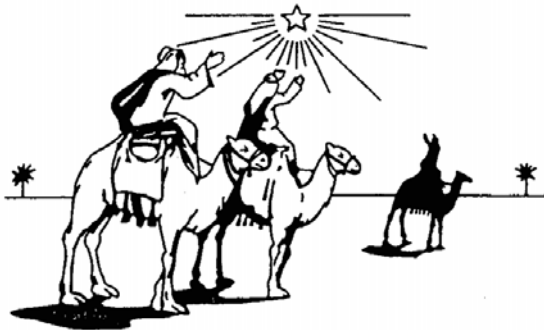
Material gifts are usually the outward sign of the deeper reality of the love and esteem the donor has for the recipient.

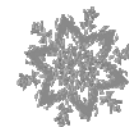
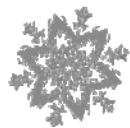
