Ministerio Juvenil

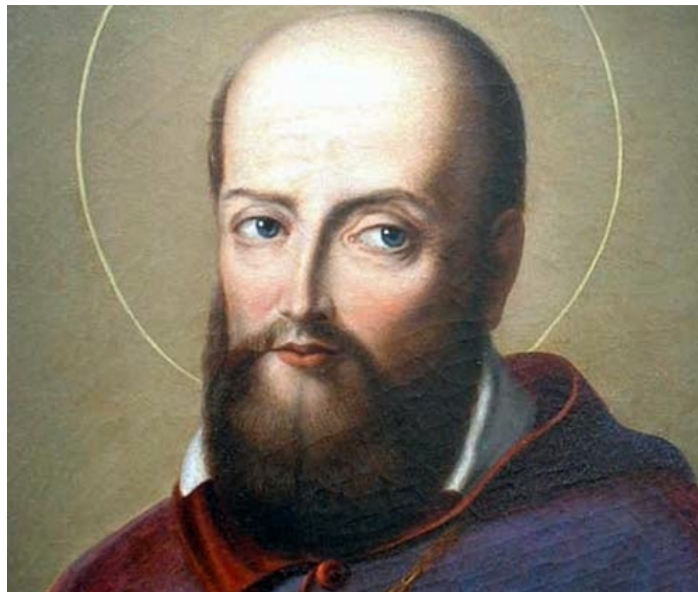
Los jóvenes de la parroquia están invitados a unirse al
