DOERS OF THE WORD

The second reading for today begins a five-week series of selections from James, a letter that is classified among the so-called “catholic” (or universal) epistles because they are addressed to a general audience rather than to one particular community. Today’s text offers important advice for Christians of every generation. God is first cited as the author of all gifts, and in particular, reference is made to the gift of baptism by which we have been made the “first fruits” of the new creation. What follows is advice based on a very Jewish understanding of the “word” as an active force, operative in the world. We are reminded that unless we, too, become “doers” of the word, our claim to faith is empty. Today and in subsequent weeks the author reminds us that it is equally important to do the “works” of love, for example, by caring for the “orphans and widows in their affliction.”

Religious Education Classes for September 2021

We are pleased to announce that registration for this upcoming catechetical year is now open.

All the children in Our Lady of Angels Parish who are in Grades 1-8 attending public, charter or private schools should be enrolled in religious education classes yearly in order to grow in our faith and prepare to receive the Sacraments.

For students who are new to our program, a copy of the birth certificate and baptism certificate must be provided. In the case of a child not being baptized as of yet, you can still register, but you must bring a copy of the birth certificate for age verification.

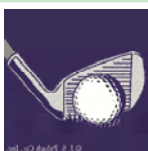

The Season of Creation is an annual ecumenical celebration beginning on September 1 and continuing until the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, October 4. During this season, we turn our attention to the marvelous world that God has created and that we are called to care for and protect. Sept. 1 happens to be the Feast of Saint Fiacre of Breuil, the priest and abbot of the seventh century who emigrated from his native Ireland to France, where he constructed for himself a hermitage together with a vegetable and herb garden, oratory, and hospice for travelers. He is the patron saint of gardeners. There is a statue of St. Fiacre in the parish house garden at St. Andrew's.
