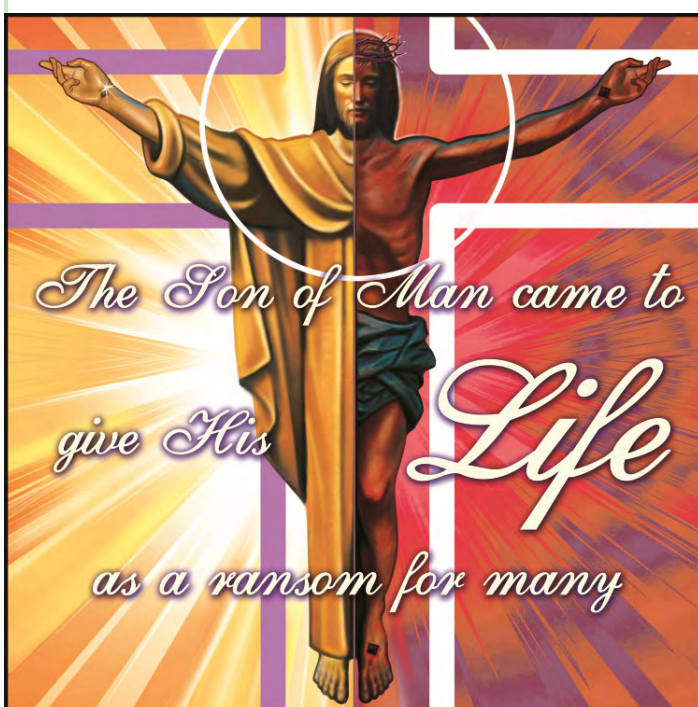

## THE HUMANITY OF JESUS CHRIST

All three readings today support—each in its own way, of course—a reflection on the humanity of Jesus Christ and how that humanity played a key role in the drama of our salvation. Although not chosen specifically to coordinate with the other two readings, today's second reading does in fact carry forward the theme of Christ's humanity in a remarkable way. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews highlights the solidarity that exists between Jesus and us, precisely because in his human nature Jesus has known the same sufferings and testing that are our own experience. Because he can "sympathize with our weaknesses," we can "approach the throne of grace to receive mercy." For the author of Hebrews, the humanity of Jesus was an essential requirement for his redemptive death, as well as an invitation to us to find in Jesus someone with whom we can identify in our daily struggles.

Dear Parishioners,

Today we welcome home Msgr. Kevin Noone as he celebrates his 51st Anniversary to the priesthood. This is a special day for Msgr., his family, our parish and for the church in Brooklyn. We give thanks to God for his priestly ministry and his wonderful service that he has given to our diocese. We continue to ask God's blessing upon him as he continues to serve the church for many years to come!!

Our sanctuary is completed. I think it came out so beautiful! It will add to the beauty of our church. As I mentioned before, the cost of this project was \$23,000. The monies came for your support of the Joe and Marge Moran golf outing. By God's blessing, the total amount raised for the golf outing was \$23,000. The exact cost of the project! God is good!! And so are the people of OLA for supporting this event. As a special thank you to the Moran family for their support and for allowing us to do this project in the sanctuary we will dedicate, at a future mass, the sanctuary in Joe and Marge Moran's honor. More details to come.

Our Annual Catholic Appeal continues to go well! We are only \$444.40 short of our goal. I sent a couple of more envelopes out to the Diocese last week which will put us a little over. Our goal is \$104,563. To date, we have pledged a total of \$104,118.50. A special thank you to those who made a pledge. Its not too late if you would like to make a pledge. Envelopes are in the back of the church. All monies over will fund our St Vincent DePaul fund and outreach to the poor provided by our Catholic Charities presence on Wednesdays.

Finally, as you may know by now, our Holy Father has called for a world wide Synod to begin in the church throughout the world. A synod is a gathering of Bishops for governing or consultation in the Catholic Church. The people of God, the laity, will be key to this process. Every parish will be asked to hold a listening session with people to talk about issues that face our church. After parishes will conduct these listening sessions, selected representatives from each parish will be invited to join the other parishes in the deanery in which we will then formalize a report that will be given to the Bishop by February 28. That report submitted to the Bishop on February 28 will be sent to Rome. This process will be followed by every diocese in the world. The Synod will conclude in 2023. More details to come.
